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# A guided participatory workshop examining the issues facing competitive taekwondo sparring and how to strategically address them.

It is widely recognized that current high-level kyorugi (taekwondo sparring) has undergone a drastic transformation. These changes are sometimes characterized as "Old School vs. New School," but we propose that the emphasis on using controversial scoring methods in conjunction with the electronic equipment is much more serious and has eroded not only the integrity and viability of this once-dynamic martial sport, but poses an existential threat to its popularity.

You are encouraged to participate in this high level, hands-on problem-solving seminar where we will do the following:

- Determine the specific problems we are trying to solve
- Discover the underlying causes of these problems
- Propose viable solutions
- Examine the potential drawbacks of any and all remedies
- Create a road map to improvement and a platform for reform
